As mathematicians, we will continue to develop our understanding of multiplication and division, including long division and the order of operations.

We will then move on to fractions, looking at equivalence, improper fractions and mixed numbers, and solving problems using these.

In PE, we will develop our invasion games skills with Miss Marshall. In our Albion sessions, we will focus on catching and fielding.

In Geography, we will look at how geographers organise the world, including latitude and longitude and time zones.
