As readers, we will enjoy reading 'The Secret Diary of Jane Pinny' by Phillip Ardagh which will encompass our learning across our topic this term and 'Hetty Feather' drama series. The children will develop their viper skills: predict, explain and summarise. We are focusing on fiction writing, such as writing diary entries and mystery stories. We will read poetry and perform showing understanding of intonation, tone, volume and action. As writers, we will create texts which vary on contents and expand our knowledge of English skills; we will compose and rehearse sentences orally and progressively building a varied and rich vocabulary.

As historians, we will study the Victorian era, developing our understanding of what life was like during Queen Victoria's reign. For example, we will compare life for children in the Victorian times to life now. We will research about Queen Victoria and understand what happened during her reign.

As linguists, we will learn how to greet people in Spanish and the numbers from 1 to 20.

In computing, we will use Scratch to design and create an educational game. We will understand fundamental concepts of computing science and algorithms. We will also be able to problem solve and help others to write programs.

In PE, we will enjoy batting games on the field with Albion in the Community, as well as gymnastics in the hall.

As scientists, we will learn about electricity. We will identify common appliances that run on electricity and construct simple series electrical circuits. We will identify whether a lamp will light in a simple series circuit and recognise that a switch opens and closes a circuit. We will also identify some common conductors and insulators. The pupils will also understand how some metals are good conductors and some are not.
