

As mathematicians, we will continue to look at fractions, including multiplying and dividing fractions. We will also look at decimals, working to order, compare, add and subtract with decimals to one and two decimal places.

In History, we will be looking at the Shang Dynasty of Ancient China. We will learn how different classes lived, the jobs they might have had, the beliefs they held, and how they used 'Oracle Bones'.

Linked to this, we will look at wider Chinese culture, learning about the importance of Chinese New Year, the symbol of the Chinese Dragon, and the Lantern Festival. We will even try our hand at some basic phrases in Mandarin!

In Music, we will be listening to, creating and evaluating music related to the four elements. We will look at famous composers and explore how we can use everyday objects to achieve different sounds.

In computing and DT, we will use Scratch to design and evaluate a prototype of an interactive toy, which we will present to the class.

As readers, we will enjoy reading a range of classic fairy tales and 'Spilled Water' by Sally Grindley. As writers, we will improve our non-fiction writing, creating non-chronological reports about Chinese New Year and writing instructions about lantern making. We will continue to build upon our story writing skills, creating fairy tales 'with a twist'.
