As scientists we will learn about different types of plants and names their parts. We will learn about wild flowers. We will also learn how flowers grow and what they need to grow and to stay alive.

As geographers we will be learning about the four countries of the United Kingdom and how each country has their own unique flag, traditions, landmarks and special days.

Using our computing skills, we will understand what an email is and how to create one. We will continue to develop our manipulative skills using the laptops and class computers to create pictures.

In PE we will be developing our athletics skills as well as learning skills for Sports Day. As writers we will be reading three new texts - There's a Tiger in the Garden, The Enormous Potato and The little gardener. We will be learning how to write about characters, create recounts and stories in a variety of ways, as well as continuing to develop our grammar, spelling and editing skills.

PE Days: Monday and Tuesday

In music we will be learning to sing with dynamics and expression, to improvise sounds to match a character, to describe music accurately, to improvise sounds to match an idea and to notate music using symbols. As mathematicians we will learn more about $\frac{1}{2}$, 1/4, 3/4, 2/4 and 1/3 of shapes and numbers. We will also learn about capacity with weight and liquids - grams, kilograms, millilitres and litres. We will find out how to use directional language as well as how to tell the time to o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past and measuring time to the nearest 5 minuntes.

As artists we will learn about the work of artists Georgia O'Keeffe and Anna Atkins. We will learn how to represent things observed with a variety of tools, quality of line and to draw through observation. We will also learn how to create a cyanotype print.

In RE we will be learning about 'What makes some places sacred to believers?' Reverend Ben will also be joining us for a lesson about this.
